



God wanted Adam to be fruitful and multiply, but he knew that Adam would never be able to handle labour pains and childbirth.


As ‘keeper of the garden’, Adam would need help finding his tools.

## TEAM ENCOURAGEMENT



Most of us understand the importance and the effectiveness of working as a team. Ecclesiastes tells us that, ‘two are better than one,’ because they have a greater reward for their labour. To put it another way the energy that is put into a task yields far better results when there are more than one of you working at it. Paul also talks about being ‘labourers together with God.’ The word here is sunergos form where we obtain our English word “synergy.” Having said all that there is an element to team working that is sometimes neglected and that’s encouragement. Ecclesiastes talks about helping one another up if we fall down as an example of this. Working as a team is more than lots of people who are able to do various things working together to complete a project. Team is about encouraging one another on when you feel like quitting.

So how do we go about actually showing this encouragement practically in the life of the church? Can I suggest a few?

- 📖 Encourage the worship team by going for it in worship with an enthusiasm that shows.
- 📖 Encourage the leadership by actually telling them that you are praying for them and that they are loved and appreciated. One of the best ways to encourage these people is to actually turn up to church and make a contribution!
- 📖 Encourage those who stand to preach and teach by nodding in agreement or the occasional ‘Amen;’ look like your interested and locked in to what they are saying – you could even take notes!
- 📖 Encourage those who are involved in cleaning and maintenance work by telling them how much their contribution is appreciated.
- 📖 Encourage those engaged in prayer and warfare – without them the whole thing would come crashing down.

If you fancy being a wet blanket of discouragement then perhaps these few pointers might help you become even more of a success than you are now.

- † Do not look bored and disinterested when someone is doing something at the front. Why not go the whole hog and lean on someone and have a quick snooze.
- † Do not walk about the church during the worship and the word that will really show your interest.
- † Do not take more notice of the children playing in the aisle than whatever God wants to do in the meeting.
- † Do not have a good chat during the reading, or the prayer, or the worship, or even the word, which will encourage the folks who are trying their best no end.

Team is more than people, tasks and goals – team is a relationship that works and which has respect for each other and the gifts that each person possesses.




My desire is that everyone in Tonypany will soon say "He leadeth me".




