Hidden mysteries in the psalms



The Book of Psalms is a collection of poems which became the hymn book of Israel. It contains five books:

Book I Psalms 1-41 Book II Psa 42-72 Book III Psa 73-89
Book IV Psa 90-106 and Book V Psa 107-150.

It is very interesting to look at the psalms which occur at the beginning and the end of the sections.

Book I *Blessed is the man who does not walk in the company of the wicked.*

Blessed is he who has regard for the weak

The psalter begins with a statement about the potential God has given to every believer to live a life of blessing. The word means to live in victory, prosperity and in an enviable state. This is the goal that we can all attain in God if we take the advice of the two psalms and not walk in the ways of the ungodly and take regard for others around us.

Book II *As the deer pants for the water so my soul longs after you O God Endow the king with your justice O God*

The only way we can reach that potential is by having a heart longing for the things of God. This includes a sense of justice which is a combination of righteousness and judgment through which we view the world.

Book III *Surely God is good to Israel to those who are pure in heart I will sing of the Lord's great love forever...His faithfulness though all generations*

Having a longing is not enough, this must be birthed into action. Those who are pure in heart are those whose acts are correctly motivated. This motivation is the same as the Lord's – love and faithfulness.

Book IV *Lord you have been our dwelling place throughout all generations*

Praise the Lord. Give thanks to the Lord for He is good. Proclaim His mighty acts

As we do what God does, we become more like him and desire our relationship with Him to deepen. This is a declaration of relationship and a proclamation of His mighty acts.

Book V *Give thanks to the Lord for He is good, His love endures forever Praise the Lord, praise God in His sanctuary*

The psalter ends with an invitation for every one and everything to praise God everywhere, especially in the sanctuary – the church.

The whole of the psalter is a progression in maturity, relationship, effectiveness and praise.

Let everything that has breath praise the Lord

The whole of our lives are meant to be the grand climax of God's redemptive strategy. Every day we play out on the stage of our lives God's grace and forgiveness, His mercy and love. The Psalms teach us how to be effective communicators by taking us step by step through the way that God has ordained.

There is a love you can't complain.
It is a love full of power and strength.
This love is so Great a love like no other.
It is a love from God the creator of all.

God's love is perfect, full of compassion, peace, power, kindness
All are given to all who ask Him into their lives.

God is love, He sent His Son to die on a cross to take away our sins.
He gave us freedom and a new way of living through the sacrifice of Jesus
on the tree.

He is the only way we have to follow, who gives us new life and life to the
full.

God's love is an eternal love. [1 Cor 13v13]


SMILE FOR YOU

An Undivided Heart




Lord, put in me a new spirit


For those who do not know who Rory and Wendy Alec are; they are the founder members of the God Channel that broadcasts on Sky Digital. Their ministry started with a great step of faith and has enabled their ministry to spread all over the world. Now Wendy Alec has started writing bible based fiction with a three parter called 'The Chronicles of Brothers', and as the name suggests the series is about the three chief Archangels, book 1 dealing mainly with the fall from grace of the 'son of the morning', Lucifer.

The action starts at an archaeological dig at Petra in the year 2017 where they find a codice entitled 'The Secret Annals of the First Heaven.....The Fall of Lucifer'. 'As recorded by Gabrielthe revelator.'

I found this book easy to read, and to follow the plot and, IMHO, it would make an excellent witnessing tool and a teaching aid particularly for the younger element, although it is also a good adult read. The story is about how man came into being and the reason, from Lucifer's point of view, for the fall. Julie having read it first said, before I started to read it, "Do you know I tend to feel sorry for Lucifer!" After reading the story myself I feel that, 'there, but for the grace of God.' I could see my faults, and it really was a little frightening to think that if it wasn't for God's amazing grace I would be going where Lucifer is going. 




It is a book that I think will make people think about where they are headed for eternity, both believer and otherwise.
